Highlights

- COVID-19 vaccines have shown to be the most effective countermeasure for preventing the transmission of COVID-19 within communities.
- This week marks another rate of transmission within each of the counties of the health district since the first case in April 2020 as more residents become fully vaccinated.
- There remains no known COVID-19-related hospitalizations or fatalities were among vaccinated persons within the health district.
- To date, there remains only ten known cases of vaccine breakthrough within the health district.
