Highlights

- **ALL RESIDENTS, REGARDLESS OF AGE, ARE URGED TO REGISTER AT [VACCINATE.NE.GOV](https://vaccinate.ne.gov) TO RECEIVE A COVID-19 VACCINE.**
- California and UK COVID-19 variants continue to be detected in the State. Residents are highly encouraged continue with face coverings, social distancing, and good hand hygiene measures to minimize the spread of these new, highly transmissible variants.
- Current tests are effective at detecting the presence of COVID-19 regardless of variant type.
- 15.99% of the eligible population over 16 years (40,394 people) have been vaccinated within the health district.
- The health district continues to vaccinate persons through Phase 1B, which includes those 65 years and older, and those in the education, food processing, grocery, and transportation sectors. - Additionally, those between the ages of 50-64, and those with underlying health conditions are now being vaccinated.
